



Scholarship Conditions

Kasetsart University Sriracha Campus Scholarship Program for ASEAN+6 and European Students Academic Year 2026

1. Undergraduate

- 1) Scholarship recipients are required to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of not lower than 3.00 per year.
- 2) Scholarship recipients are required to produce at least one academic piece of work per person, which may be presented at national or international conferences (or at undergraduate-level forums) within the scholarship period.
- 3) Scholarship recipients are required to participate in assisting the Faculty of Economics at Sriracha in organizing the activities, including cultural exchange activities or producing media to promote the Faculty as Student Ambassadors, within the scholarship period.
- 4) Scholarship recipients are required to attend the workshops for at least 2 skills from the following skills.
 - Digital & Data Literacy
 - Critical Thinking
 - Communication Skill
 - Innovation & Creativity
 - Leadership & Social Responsibility

In addition, scholarship recipients are required to provide empirical evidence, such as a workshop certificate, within the scholarship period.

2. Graduate

- 1) Scholarship recipients are required to publish research supported by the grant in an international academic journal indexed in the Scopus database. Moreover, the research must be published or accepted for publication within the period specified in the Graduate School's graduation regulations.
- 2) Scholarship recipients are required to participate in assisting the Faculty of Economics at Sriracha in organizing the activities, including cultural exchange activities or producing media to promote the Faculty as Student Ambassadors, within the scholarship period.
